He is chair of House Ecology and Parks, and a member of the Capital Budget and Transportation committees.. He is the House Democratic Caucus representative to the Washington State Climate Advisory Team, which brings together lawmakers, business leaders, and climate experts to identify ways this state can fight climate change. Among his legislative priorities are protecting our environment, strengthening our economy, and creating jobs.
