

# WSUU Covid-19 Guidelines as of 11/9/20

WSUU's current Covid-19 Guidelines do not sanction in-person gathering for official church activities, including worship, fundraising, auction items, small group ministry, committee, and board work.

These limitations do not include actions that are necessary for church functioning and maintenance that can not be accomplished remotely, which are expected to be done with all safety precautions in place, including face masks, 6-ft of distance between people, and contact limits that accord with King County's phase (currently phase 2, maximum of 5 people outside a household per week), such as:

- Garden and outdoor grounds maintenance
- Indoor maintenance, repair, and upgrades to the building
- Case-by-case ministerial pastoral care
- Signing of checks and documents
- Pick-up, drop off, and delivery of materials

The limitations also do not include individual congregants, outside the context of official church activities, exercising their individual judgment about how and when in-person contact with other individual congregants may feel important and appropriate for a variety of reasons.
